The kick was not good, but the score stood 12 to 7, Permian, at halftime.

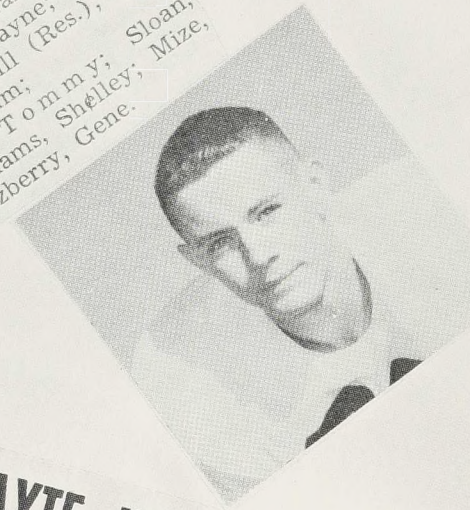
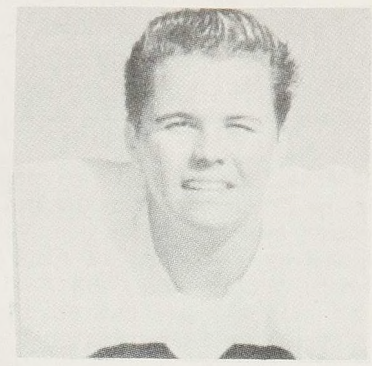
