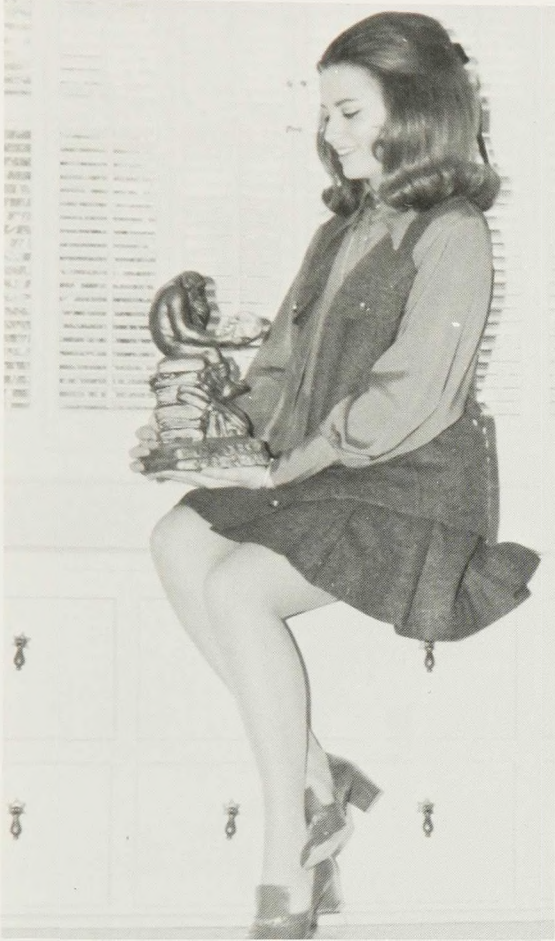
While in Austin, they participated in a detailed study of government. Besides the Senate and House of Representatives affairs, they became active in political campaigns and elections.

We Panthers are proud to have these students as representatives of our school.

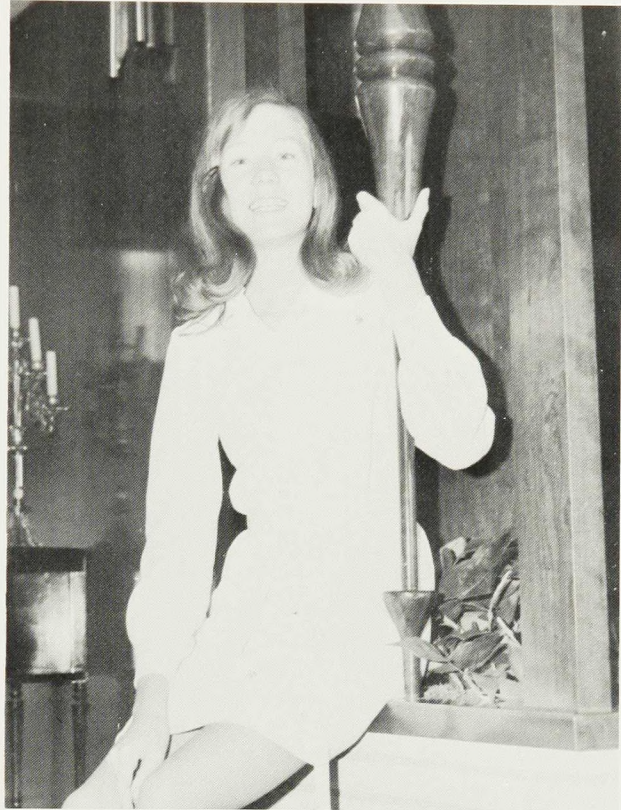
